## Chair Auditions

1. Scales (SCALES DO NOT HAVE TO BE MEMORIZED. YOU WILL USE A CLEAN PIECE OF SHEET MUSIC FOR THE AUDITION)

Chromatic Scale
3 Chromatically adjacent scales (2 octaves (played correctly) for extra points)
2 points for all the notes going up
2 points for all the notes going down
1 point for the Arpeggio
25 POINTS TOTAL
2. Prepare piece 100 POINTS TOTAL
-1 point for incorrect notes
-2 points for incorrect rhythms
-1 point for every missed dynamics
-1 point for incorrect tempo
3. Prepared Piece (1 copy is provided)
