- Call to Order/Opening Prayer Alani Rodgers
- **Approval of Minutes from Aug and Oct Meetings** -- Mary Ankerson moved to approve the minutes, and Jay Graham seconded. Minutes were approved.
- **Band Director's Report** Mr. Noah
  - Semi-Final Playoff Game. The band will leave school at 1130 tomorrow and will eat lunch on the bus (lunch provided by band boosters). They will be given \$5 stipend by the school admin to purchase supper. The buses will go to Peachtree Mall in Columbus, GA where members will have time to eat, walk around, and change into their band uniforms. Buses are expected to return to school at about 2 a.m. (State Final game will be played on Wed, Dec 2, at Bryant-Denny Stadium in Tuscaloosa.)
  - Raffle Tickets. Each student will be responsible for selling 20 raffle tickets with half of money raised going to students' NYC trip accounts. Raffle ticket money should be turned in by Fri, Dec 4.
  - New York Trip. All who are going on the NYC trip need to get their accounts current with Perform America. The money is needed to purchase tickets for the Broadway show we will see, *Wicked*. All of us will fly out of New Orleans airport in two planes and will be landing at two airports. Buses will transport all to the hotel.

- Vice Presidents' Reports Karen Charnock and Nancy Little
  - Fundraisers. Poinsettia sales- First order forms due today and will be delivered Nov 24. Second order is due Nov 30 and will be delivered Dec 4.

  - **Financial Update**. There is currently \$6,000 in the band booster account. Approximately \$4,400 was raised for St. Jude on behalf of the Griffin family. The biggest expense in the spring will be the band banquet which will cost approx \$3,000 the students' dinners.
