Flute and cleaning rod, slams cloth, polishing cloth, wire music stand

Clarinet and 5 reeds (strength 2 1/2), swab, Cork Grease , wire music stand

Alto Saxophone and 5 reeds (strength 2 1/2), swab, Cork Grease, wire music stand

French Horn and valve oil, tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, polish cloth, wire music stand

Trumpet and valve oil, tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, polish cloth, wire music stand

Trombone and slide oil tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, polish cloth, wire music stand

Baritone/Euphonium (instrument provided by McT Band) and slide oil tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, polish cloth, wire music stand

Tuba (instrument provided by McT Band) and slide oil tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, polish cloth, wire music stand

We have some instruments available for students. If you have difficulty finding an instrument - please let your director before September 18th.

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD BE IN THE BAND

Research made between music and intelligence concluded that music training is far greater than computer instruction and athletics in improving children's abstract reasoning skills. Students with coursework/experience in music performance scored higher on the SAT: students in music performance scored 57 points higher on the verbal and 41 points higher on the math, and students in music appreciation scored 63 points higher on verbal and 44 points higher on the math, than did students with no arts participation in middle and through high school.

WHAT IF I WANT TO BE IN THE BAND AND PLAY A SPORT OR CHEERLEAD?

The McGill-Toolen Prep Band and Directors understand the importance of a well-rounded education. Participation in one or multiple extra curricular activities can be a part of that education.

Any beginner percussion member who attends the majority (only missing two rehearsals per year) Honor Band Percussion Rehearsals will be a member of the Honor Band and Tour Band. This is an honor usually reserved for older members of the prep band.
