### WELCOME TO AUSTRIA

Your flight will land at VIE this morning. After clearing customs and retrieving your luggage, you will be greeted by your local tour managers and showed to your private transportation.

### VIENNA

Elegant Vienna has narrow streets lined with splendid mansions, spacious parks, palaces and museums, and some of the world's smartest shops. The ever-curving promenade, the Ring, follows part of the old city wall. Within the Ring is famous St. Stephen's Cathedral.

Vienna is also touted as one of the great music capitals of the world! Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven, Schubert, Brahms, Strauss and Mahler are only a few of the musicians who lived and worked here.

### VIENNA CENTRAL CEMETERY

The Vienna Central Cemetery is one of the largest cemeteries in the world by number of interred, and is the most famous cemetery among Vienna's nearly 50 cemeteries.

Here you will see the tombs and memorials of famous composers such as Beethoven, Mozart, the Strauss family and Brahms.

### CITY TOUR OF VIENNA

On today's guided tour of Vienna, you will be introduced to the special atmosphere of Old Vienna. Of particular interest are the beautifully preserved imperial palaces and churches.

**Schloss Esterhazy**

**BREAKFAST**

**SCHLOSS ESTERHAZY**

Board your coach and transfer to Esterhazy to enjoy a guided visit of Schloss Esterhazy and the Haydnsaal. The palace was built in the 13th century and later it was converted into a baroque building by the most powerful Hungarian Esterhazy Family. The Haydnsaal ranks among the most beautiful and acoustically perfect concert halls of the world. Its name goes back to the famous composer Joseph Haydn, who worked for nearly forty years in the service of the Esterházy family.

**LEISURE TIME**

Have some free time this afternoon for sightseeing and shopping in Vienna.

**REHEARSAL**

There will be time for a short rehearsal prior to this evening's performance.

**Salzburg**

**BREAKFAST**

Breakfast will be provided this morning.

**SALZBURG**

Beautifully situated along the Salzach River in western Austria, Salzburg is the country's 4th largest city and its old town (Altstadt) is one of the best preserved city centers north of the Alps.

Birthplace to Mozart and home to many shops, restaurants and hotels from the 13th - 15th centuries, Salzburg is known also for the (relatively ) modern Mirabell Gardens and as the main setting for the story and filming of "The Sound of Music." Dominated by its great castle, Hohensalzburg, the town's Baroque architecture and great beauty have made it famous world-wide.

**SALZBURG WALKING TOUR**

Guided walking tour of Salzburg, where you will see the main sights such as the Salzburger Dom, Hohenfortress Salzburg. Visit Mozart's Birthplace, where you can see the violin he played when he was only 5 years old!

Check-in to your Salzburg hotel this afternoon.

**NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE**

Appearing through the mountaintops like a mirage, Schloss Neuschwanstein was the model for Disney's Sleeping Beauty castle. King Ludwig II planned this fairy-tale pile himself, with the help of a stage designer rather than an architect. He envisioned it as a giant stage on which to recreate the world of Germanic mythology, inspired by the operatic works of his friend Richard Wagner.

**MUNICH**

Munich, the capital city of Bavaria, is the third-largest city in Germany and full of centuries-old homes and traditions. Check out the Old Town and the beer halls that make the annual Oktoberfest a favorite.
