- For Away Games: The children will stay at school, be fed dinner at school, dress for the game and leave from school on the bus. Should you want to check your child(ren) off the bus after the away game you must FIRST fill out the "One Way Form," found on the band Resource page (<u>http://</u> <u>mctband.org/resources/</u>), by 8am on game day.
- Uniforms Care You can find Uniform Care directions on the band Resource page (http://mctband.org/resources/). NEVER USE Fabric Softeners or dry in the dryer, uniforms can be washed in the machine with a clear detergent and then hung to dry. This includes Band Polos.
